CB-AG10 Guitar Gig Bag

And with the padded handle and straps, the player can comfortably carry their instrument by hand or backpack style. There's a large, flat accessory pocket for

strings, cables, and a mobile device, plus a small upper pocket for a clip-on tuner, capo, and other compact items.

The CB-AG10's soft velvet interior and padded neck support provide a safe and stable environment for the user's guitar. The support elevates the headstock to help keep it protected, and it can be detached and repositioned for the optimum fit. An integrated strap holds the neck securely in place during transport.

CB-EG01 Guitar Gig Bag

Stylish and protective, the CB-EG01 is the new slimline model in the BOSS CB-EG lineup of electric guitar bags, which also includes the deluxe [CB-EG10](#) and premium [CB-EG20](#). This quality bag features rugged materials and a light, low-profile design that reduces bulk while moving about town. The soft velvet interior protects the instrument's finish, while the adjustable neck rest offers solid support during transport.

The CB-EG01's main handle is comfortable to grab, and two padded straps support backpack-style carrying over longer distances. There's also a convenient loop handle on the back and a generous front pocket to store strings, cables, a tuner, and other items.
