Each BIC-P cable features an 18 AWG multi-strand center conductor made with 99.99% pure oxygen-free mono-crystal copper, delivering full, balanced tone with warmth, punch, and clarity. Braided mono-crystal copper shielding and 24K gold-plated connectors further enhance performance, while a stylish woven outer jacket coils smoothly and provides lasting durability.

BIC-P premium instrument cables are available in 10 ft./3 m and 18 ft./5.5 m lengths with straight-to-straight 1/4-inch connectors (<u>BIC-P10</u>, BIC-P18) and straight-to-right angle 1/4-inch connectors (<u>BIC-P10A</u>, BIC-P18A).
